**Jon Mills, Ph.D., Psy.D., ABPP** is a Canadian philosopher and psychoanalyst. He is a retired board-certified clinical psychologist and psychoanalyst, Diplomate & Fellow with the American Board of Professional Psychology, and retired psychologist with the College of Psychologists of Ontario. He holds six university and post-graduate degrees including two doctorates, as well as post-doctoral training and international scholarly recognition. Dr. Mills received his Psy.D. (Doctor of Psychology) in Clinical Psychology from the Illinois School of Professional Psychology in Chicago, his Ph.D. in Philosophy from Vanderbilt University in Nashville, Tennessee, and was a Fulbright scholar of philosophy at the University of Toronto and York University. With over thirty years of clinical experience, he specialized in the assessment and treatment of many psychological disorders upon which he is widely published. He is a Fellow with the American Board and Academy of Psychoanalysis, American Academy of Clinical Psychology, and the Section on Psychoanalytic and Psychodynamic Psychology of the Canadian Psychological Association. He is Editor of four international book series, author and/or editor of over two-hundred peer reviewed publications

including over 35 books; is Honorary Professor, Department of Psychosocial and Psychoanalytic Studies, University of Essex, UK; on Faculty & Clinical Associate in the Postgraduate Programs in Psychoanalysis & Psychotherapy, Gordon F. Derner School of Psychology, Adelphi University, USA and the New School for Existential Psychoanalysis, USA; and is Emeritus Professor of Psychology and Psychoanalysis at the Adler Graduate Professional School in Toronto where he taught for over 20 years. In 2006, 2011, 2013, 2018, and 2022 he was recognized with a Gradiva Award from the National Association for the Advancement of Psychoanalysis in New York City for his scholarship, received a Significant Contribution to Canadian Psychology Award in 2008, a Goethe Award for best book in 2013, and the Otto Weininger Memorial Award for lifetime achievement in 2015 by the Section on Psychoanalytic and Psychodynamic Psychology of the Canadian Psychological Association. He ran a mental health corporation in Ontario, Canada and was the only Canadian psychologist who had double board ABPP certifications in clinical psychology and psychoanalysis before he retired from clinical practice in 2021.
